Plan Your Journey

- Know where the interview is
- Arrive 10–15 minutes early 0

For In-Person Interviews

- Greet Politely
- Smile 😊
- Shake hands firmly 🤝
- Say "Good morning" or "Nice to meet you"

Listen Carefully

- Answer clearly 6
- Ask for repetition if needed

Be Honest

- Share your true experience and skills
- Show Enthusiasm
- Smile and make eye contact 👀
- Let them know you want the job

? Ask Questions

- "What are the next steps?"

For Online Interviews

- Check Your Technology
- Test your camera, mic, and internet 🎧 📶
- Use headphones if possible

Choose a Quiet Place

- Find a quiet, well-lit spot 💡 😜
- Look at the Camera
- Feels like eye contact **Q**

Speak Clearly

- Talk slowly and clearly
- Don't talk over the interviewer III

Stay Focused

• Don't check your phone or look away 🖽 🚫

After the Interview

🙏 Say Thank You

• Thank the interviewer before leaving or ending the call 🙌

Follow Up

• If you don't hear back after a week, it's okay to send a polite email asking for an update
